

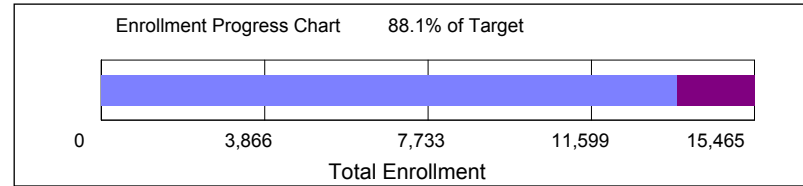

## Reading the Brooklyn College Spring 2022 Enrollment Report

The Brooklyn College Spring 2022 enrollment report is published daily by the Office of Institutional Research and Data Analysis (IRDA) and tracks enrollment of students throughout the Spring 2022 registration period. Some highlights of today's report:

- The bar chart tells us that as of January 26, 2022, **13,620** students have enrolled in Brooklyn College this semester. This represents **88.07%** of the target, which is **15,465**
- As of today, total Spring 2022 enrollment is **12.35%** lower compared with what it was at approximately this time last year.
- As of today, total Spring 2022 enrollment is **16.52%** lower compared with final form-A enrollment in Spring 2021.

These totals are broken down into different categories of students:

**Undergraduate** enrollment is **13.31%** lower compared to what it was this time last year, and is **16.95%** lower compared to the final Spring 2021 number.

- Non-SEEK first time freshman enrollment is **17.39%** lower compared to what it was this time last year, and is **13.64%** lower compared to the final Spring 2021 number.
- Non-SEEK entering transfer enrollment is **12.26%** lower compared to what it was this time last year, and is **11.62%** lower compared to the final Spring 2021 number.

**Graduate** enrollment is **7.15%** lower compared to what it was this time last year, and is **14.24%** lower compared to the final Spring 2021 number.

- Entering graduate enrollment is **6.94%** lower compared to what it was this time last year, and is **14.10%** lower compared to the final Spring 2021 number.
