For each course, this chart shows:

The course name and title

Winter 2019: The number of students enrolled for the January Intersession 2019 as of the latest available data (December 14, 2018).

Difference From Minimum: The difference between the enrollment count and the minimum enrollment count needed for the course to meet its expenses, which is set at 15 for all courses.

**<u>Revenue Estimate Per Student</u>**: The tuition charge for each individual student enrolled in the class, given the number of credits and assuming all students are charged a part time, degree-seeking, in-state rate.

Revenue Estimate Total: The product of the enrollment count and the revenue estimate per students; or, the total tuition charges for the course.

The chart tells us that **1,831** undergraduate students are enrolled in courses offered in the 2019 January intersession, and that the total tuition revenue from these students is **\$1,593,720.00**. It tells us that **227** graduate students are enrolled in courses offered in the 2019 January intersession, and that the total tuition revenue from these students is **\$299,640.00**.
