As of the most recent available data (**December 13, 2018**), **1.9% more** undergraduates have enrolled for the 2019 January Intersession than were enrolled in the 2018 January Intersession at this time last year. They are taking **6.0% more** credits than they were at this time last year. There are **8.0% fewer** undergraduates enrolled for the 2019 January Intersession than the final enrollment count for the 2018 January Intersession, and this constitutes **0.5% more** credits.

As of the most recent available data (**December 13, 2018**), **28.1% fewer** graduate students have enrolled for the 2019 January Intersession than were enrolled in the 2018 January Intersession at this time last year. They are taking **30.2% fewer** credits than they were at this time last year. There are **50.5% fewer** graduate students enrolled for the 2019 January Intersession than the final enrollment count for the 2018 January Intersession, and this constitutes **51.1% fewer** credits.
