As of the most recent available data (**December 17, 2018**), **1.7% more** undergraduates have enrolled for the 2019 January Intersession than were enrolled in the 2018 January Intersession at this time last year. They are taking **5.8% more** credits than they were at this time last year. There are **5.0% fewer** undergraduates enrolled for the 2019 January Intersession than the final enrollment count for the 2018 January Intersession, and this constitutes **4.1% more** credits.

As of the most recent available data (**December 17, 2018**), **12.0% fewer** graduate students have enrolled for the 2019 January Intersession than were enrolled in the 2018 January Intersession at this time last year. They are taking **14.6% fewer** credits than they were at this time last year. There are **36.4% fewer** graduate students enrolled for the 2019 January Intersession than the final enrollment count for the 2018 January Intersession, and this constitutes **37.6% fewer** credits.
