As of the most recent available data (**December 18, 2018**), **1.3% fewer** undergraduates have enrolled for the 2019 January Intersession than were enrolled in the 2018 January Intersession at this time last year. They are taking **3.6% more** credits than they were at this time last year. There are **4.6% fewer** undergraduates enrolled for the 2019 January Intersession than the final enrollment count for the 2018 January Intersession, and this constitutes **4.7% more** credits.

As of the most recent available data (**December 18, 2018**), **14.2% fewer** graduate students have enrolled for the 2019 January Intersession than were enrolled in the 2018 January Intersession at this time last year. They are taking **17.1% fewer** credits than they were at this time last year. There are **36.4% fewer** graduate students enrolled for the 2019 January Intersession than the final enrollment count for the 2018 January Intersession, and this constitutes **37.6% fewer** credits.
