As of the most recent available data (**December 19, 2018**), **2.3% fewer** undergraduates have enrolled for the 2019 January Intersession than were enrolled in the 2018 January Intersession at this time last year. They are taking **2.8% more** credits than they were at this time last year. There are **4.6% fewer** undergraduates enrolled for the 2019 January Intersession than the final enrollment count for the 2018 January Intersession, and this constitutes **5.0% more** credits.

As of the most recent available data (**December 19, 2018**), **12.4% fewer** graduate students have enrolled for the 2019 January Intersession than were enrolled in the 2018 January Intersession at this time last year. They are taking **14.9% fewer** credits than they were at this time last year. There are **34.1% fewer** graduate students enrolled for the 2019 January Intersession than the final enrollment count for the 2018 January Intersession, and this constitutes **35.1% fewer** credits.
