As of the most recent available data (**January 02, 2019**), **0.1% more** undergraduates have enrolled for the 2019 January Intersession than were enrolled in the 2018 January Intersession at this time last year. They are taking **3.9% more** credits than they were at this time last year. There are **3.7% fewer** undergraduates enrolled for the 2019 January Intersession than the final enrollment count for the 2018 January Intersession, and this constitutes **4.8% more** credits.

As of the most recent available data (**January 02, 2019**), **19.6% fewer** graduate students have enrolled for the 2019 January Intersession than were enrolled in the 2018 January Intersession at this time last year. They are taking **22.0% fewer** credits than they were at this time last year. There are **32.0% fewer** graduate students enrolled for the 2019 January Intersession than the final enrollment count for the 2018 January Intersession, and this constitutes **33.1% fewer** credits.
