As of the most recent available data (January 03, 2019), 0.2% fewer undergraduates have enrolled for the 2019 January Intersession than were enrolled in the 2018 January Intersession at this time last year. They are taking 3.4% more credits than they were at this time last year. There are 4.0% fewer undergraduates enrolled for the 2019 January Intersession than the final enrollment count for the 2018 January Intersession, and this constitutes 4.3% more credits.

As of the most recent available data (January 03, 2019), 19.6% fewer graduate students have enrolled for the 2019 January Intersession than were enrolled in the 2018 January Intersession at this time last year. They are taking 22.0% fewer credits than they were at this time last year. There are 32.0% fewer graduate students enrolled for the 2019 January Intersession than the final enrollment count for the 2018 January Intersession, and this constitutes 33.1% fewer credits.
