As of the most recent available data (**January 03, 2019**), **0.2% fewer** undergraduates have enrolled for the 2019 January Intersession than were enrolled in the 2018 January Intersession at this time last year. They are taking **3.4% more** credits than they were at this time last year. There are **4.0% fewer** undergraduates enrolled for the 2019 January Intersession than the final enrollment count for the 2018 January Intersession, and this constitutes **4.3% more** credits.

As of the most recent available data (**January 03, 2019**), **19.6% fewer** graduate students have enrolled for the 2019 January Intersession than were enrolled in the 2018 January Intersession at this time last year. They are taking **22.0% fewer** credits than they were at this time last year. There are **32.0% fewer** graduate students enrolled for the 2019 January Intersession than the final enrollment count for the 2018 January Intersession, and this constitutes **33.1% fewer** credits.
