As of the most recent available data (January 04, 2019), 0.5% fewer undergraduates have enrolled for the 2019 January Intersession than were enrolled in the 2018 January Intersession at this time last year. They are taking 2.9% more credits than they were at this time last year. There are 4.6% fewer undergraduates enrolled for the 2019 January Intersession than the final enrollment count for the 2018 January Intersession, and this constitutes 3.6% more credits.

As of the most recent available data (January 04, 2019), 20.2% fewer graduate students have enrolled for the 2019 January Intersession than were enrolled in the 2018 January Intersession at this time last year. They are taking 22.8% fewer credits than they were at this time last year. There are 32.5% fewer graduate students enrolled for the 2019 January Intersession than the final enrollment count for the 2018 January Intersession, and this constitutes 33.8% fewer credits.
