As of the most recent available data (**November 06, 2019**), **40.7% more** undergraduates have enrolled for the 2020 January Intersession than were enrolled in the 2019 January Intersession at this time last year. They are taking **36.6% more** credits than they were at this time last year. There are **46.4% fewer** undergraduates enrolled for the 2020 January Intersession than the final enrollment count for the 2019 January Intersession, and this constitutes **42.6% fewer** credits.

As of the most recent available data (**November 06, 2019**), **240.9% more** graduate students have enrolled for the 2020 January Intersession than were enrolled in the 2019 January Intersession at this time last year. They are taking **207.2% more** credits than they were at this time last year. There are **74.6% fewer** graduate students enrolled for the 2020 January Intersession than the final enrollment count for the 2019 January Intersession, and this constitutes **76.5% fewer** credits.
