As of the most recent available data (**November 07, 2019**), **27.7% more** undergraduates have enrolled for the 2020 January Intersession than were enrolled in the 2019 January Intersession at this time last year. They are taking **25.4% more** credits than they were at this time last year. There are **42.3% fewer** undergraduates enrolled for the 2020 January Intersession than the final enrollment count for the 2019 January Intersession, and this constitutes **38.6% fewer** credits.

As of the most recent available data (**November 07, 2019**), **273.9% more** graduate students have enrolled for the 2020 January Intersession than were enrolled in the 2019 January Intersession at this time last year. They are taking **243.1% more** credits than they were at this time last year. There are **70.8% fewer** graduate students enrolled for the 2020 January Intersession than the final enrollment count for the 2019 January Intersession, and this constitutes **72.6% fewer** credits.
