As of the most recent available data (**November 08, 2019**), **20.3% more** undergraduates have enrolled for the 2020 January Intersession than were enrolled in the 2019 January Intersession at this time last year. They are taking **19.8% more** credits than they were at this time last year. There are **37.4% fewer** undergraduates enrolled for the 2020 January Intersession than the final enrollment count for the 2019 January Intersession, and this constitutes **33.7% fewer** credits.

As of the most recent available data (**November 08, 2019**), **264.0% more** graduate students have enrolled for the 2020 January Intersession than were enrolled in the 2019 January Intersession at this time last year. They are taking **223.5% more** credits than they were at this time last year. There are **69.2% fewer** graduate students enrolled for the 2020 January Intersession than the final enrollment count for the 2019 January Intersession, and this constitutes **71.0% fewer** credits.
