As of the most recent available data (**November 11, 2019**), 5.2% more undergraduates have enrolled for the 2020 January Intersession than were enrolled in the 2019 January Intersession at this time last year. They are taking 6.9% more credits than they were at this time last year. There are 33.7% fewer undergraduates enrolled for the 2020 January Intersession than the final enrollment count for the 2019 January Intersession, and this constitutes 29.8% fewer credits.

As of the most recent available data (**November 11, 2019**), **122.4% more** graduate students have enrolled for the 2020 January Intersession than were enrolled in the 2019 January Intersession at this time last year. They are taking **105.9% more** credits than they were at this time last year. There are **63.1% fewer** graduate students enrolled for the 2020 January Intersession than the final enrollment count for the 2019 January Intersession, and this constitutes **65.1% fewer** credits.
