As of the most recent available data (November 14, 2019), 9.7% more undergraduates have enrolled for the 2020 January Intersession than were enrolled in the 2019 January Intersession at this time last year. They are taking 12.4% more credits than they were at this time last year. There are 11.3% fewer undergraduates enrolled for the 2020 January Intersession than the final enrollment count for the 2019 January Intersession, and this constitutes 7.1% fewer credits.

As of the most recent available data (November 14, 2019), 89.6% more graduate students have enrolled for the 2020 January Intersession than were enrolled in the 2019 January Intersession at this time last year. They are taking 82.9% more credits than they were at this time last year. There are 50.5% fewer graduate students enrolled for the 2020 January Intersession than the final enrollment count for the 2019 January Intersession, and this constitutes 51.4% fewer credits.
