As of the most recent available data (**November 18, 2019**), **6.4% more** undergraduates have enrolled for the 2020 January Intersession than were enrolled in the 2019 January Intersession at this time last year. They are taking **8.5% more** credits than they were at this time last year. There are **4.4% fewer** undergraduates enrolled for the 2020 January Intersession than the final enrollment count for the 2019 January Intersession, and this constitutes **0.3% fewer** credits.

As of the most recent available data (November 18, 2019), 19.9% more graduate students have enrolled for the 2020 January Intersession than were enrolled in the 2019 January Intersession at this time last year. They are taking 14.8% more credits than they were at this time last year. There are 42.7% fewer graduate students enrolled for the 2020 January Intersession than the final enrollment count for the 2019 January Intersession, and this constitutes 43.2% fewer credits.
