As of the most recent available data (November 21, 2019), 12.7% more undergraduates have enrolled for the 2020 January Intersession than were enrolled in the 2019 January Intersession at this time last year. They are taking 15.5% more credits than they were at this time last year. There are 1.3% more undergraduates enrolled for the 2020 January Intersession than the final enrollment count for the 2019 January Intersession, and this constitutes 6.1% more credits.

As of the most recent available data (November 21, 2019), 26.2% more graduate students have enrolled for the 2020 January Intersession than were enrolled in the 2019 January Intersession at this time last year. They are taking 19.5% more credits than they were at this time last year. There are 39.7% fewer graduate students enrolled for the 2020 January Intersession than the final enrollment count for the 2019 January Intersession, and this constitutes 40.9% fewer credits.
