As of the most recent available data (November 25, 2019), 17.7% more undergraduates have enrolled for the 2020 January Intersession than were enrolled in the 2019 January Intersession at this time last year. They are taking 19.9% more credits than they were at this time last year. There are 5.8% more undergraduates enrolled for the 2020 January Intersession than the final enrollment count for the 2019 January Intersession, and this constitutes 10.1% more credits.

As of the most recent available data (November 25, 2019), 37.6% more graduate students have enrolled for the 2020 January Intersession than were enrolled in the 2019 January Intersession at this time last year. They are taking 30.9% more credits than they were at this time last year. There are 34.2% fewer graduate students enrolled for the 2020 January Intersession than the final enrollment count for the 2019 January Intersession, and this constitutes 35.2% fewer credits.
