As of the most recent available data (**November 29, 2019**), **18.2% more** undergraduates have enrolled for the 2020 January Intersession than were enrolled in the 2019 January Intersession at this time last year. They are taking **20.0% more** credits than they were at this time last year. There are **10.5% more** undergraduates enrolled for the 2020 January Intersession than the final enrollment count for the 2019 January Intersession, and this constitutes **15.0% more** credits.

As of the most recent available data (**November 29, 2019**), **13.1% more** graduate students have enrolled for the 2020 January Intersession than were enrolled in the 2019 January Intersession at this time last year. They are taking **8.1% more** credits than they were at this time last year. There are **32.5% fewer** graduate students enrolled for the 2020 January Intersession than the final enrollment count for the 2019 January Intersession, and this constitutes **33.6% fewer** credits.
