As of the most recent available data (**December 03, 2019**), **20.1% more** undergraduates have enrolled for the 2020 January Intersession than were enrolled in the 2019 January Intersession at this time last year. They are taking **22.0% more** credits than they were at this time last year. There are **12.2% more** undergraduates enrolled for the 2020 January Intersession than the final enrollment count for the 2019 January Intersession, and this constitutes **16.9% more** credits.

As of the most recent available data (**December 03, 2019**), **10.7% more** graduate students have enrolled for the 2020 January Intersession than were enrolled in the 2019 January Intersession at this time last year. They are taking **6.1% more** credits than they were at this time last year. There are **29.8% fewer** graduate students enrolled for the 2020 January Intersession than the final enrollment count for the 2019 January Intersession, and this constitutes **30.9% fewer** credits.
