As of the most recent available data (**December 04, 2019**), **21.6% more** undergraduates have enrolled for the 2020 January Intersession than were enrolled in the 2019 January Intersession at this time last year. They are taking **23.9% more** credits than they were at this time last year. There are **13.7% more** undergraduates enrolled for the 2020 January Intersession than the final enrollment count for the 2019 January Intersession, and this constitutes **18.5% more** credits.

As of the most recent available data (**December 04, 2019**), **7.7% more** graduate students have enrolled for the 2020 January Intersession than were enrolled in the 2019 January Intersession at this time last year. They are taking **2.5% more** credits than they were at this time last year. There are **28.8% fewer** graduate students enrolled for the 2020 January Intersession than the final enrollment count for the 2019 January Intersession, and this constitutes **30.6% fewer** credits.
