As of the most recent available data (**December 05, 2019**), **21.7% more** undergraduates have enrolled for the 2020 January Intersession than were enrolled in the 2019 January Intersession at this time last year. They are taking **24.0% more** credits than they were at this time last year. There are **14.8% more** undergraduates enrolled for the 2020 January Intersession than the final enrollment count for the 2019 January Intersession, and this constitutes **19.9% more** credits.

As of the most recent available data (**December 05, 2019**), **26.3% more** graduate students have enrolled for the 2020 January Intersession than were enrolled in the 2019 January Intersession at this time last year. They are taking **20.3% more** credits than they were at this time last year. There are **15.3% fewer** graduate students enrolled for the 2020 January Intersession than the final enrollment count for the 2019 January Intersession, and this constitutes **17.3% fewer** credits.
