As of the most recent available data (**December 06, 2019**), 23.4% more undergraduates have enrolled for the 2020 January Intersession than were enrolled in the 2019 January Intersession at this time last year. They are taking 25.4% more credits than they were at this time last year. There are 16.9% more undergraduates enrolled for the 2020 January Intersession than the final enrollment count for the 2019 January Intersession, and this constitutes 21.8% more credits.

As of the most recent available data (**December 06, 2019**), 23.5% more graduate students have enrolled for the 2020 January Intersession than were enrolled in the 2019 January Intersession at this time last year. They are taking 18.3% more credits than they were at this time last year. There are 14.6% fewer graduate students enrolled for the 2020 January Intersession than the final enrollment count for the 2019 January Intersession, and this constitutes 16.3% fewer credits.
