As of the most recent available data (**December 09, 2019**), **24.0% more** undergraduates have enrolled for the 2020 January Intersession than were enrolled in the 2019 January Intersession at this time last year. They are taking **26.0% more** credits than they were at this time last year. There are **18.2% more** undergraduates enrolled for the 2020 January Intersession than the final enrollment count for the 2019 January Intersession, and this constitutes **23.0% more** credits.

As of the most recent available data (**December 09, 2019**), 22.5% more graduate students have enrolled for the 2020 January Intersession than were enrolled in the 2019 January Intersession at this time last year. They are taking 17.0% more credits than they were at this time last year. There are 13.2% fewer graduate students enrolled for the 2020 January Intersession than the final enrollment count for the 2019 January Intersession, and this constitutes 15.3% fewer credits.
