As of the most recent available data (**December 13, 2019**), **28.4% more** undergraduates have enrolled for the 2020 January Intersession than were enrolled in the 2019 January Intersession at this time last year. They are taking **29.8% more** credits than they were at this time last year. There are **23.2% more** undergraduates enrolled for the 2020 January Intersession than the final enrollment count for the 2019 January Intersession, and this constitutes **29.2% more** credits.

As of the most recent available data (**December 13, 2019**), **35.9% more** graduate students have enrolled for the 2020 January Intersession than were enrolled in the 2019 January Intersession at this time last year. They are taking **30.1% more** credits than they were at this time last year. There are **same** graduate students enrolled for the 2020 January Intersession than the final enrollment count for the 2019 January Intersession, and this constitutes **1.9% fewer** credits.
