As of the most recent available data (**December 18, 2019**), **23.3% more** undergraduates have enrolled for the 2020 January Intersession than were enrolled in the 2019 January Intersession at this time last year. They are taking **25.1% more** credits than they were at this time last year. There are **20.9% more** undergraduates enrolled for the 2020 January Intersession than the final enrollment count for the 2019 January Intersession, and this constitutes **27.4% more** credits.

As of the most recent available data (**December 18, 2019**), **8.5% more** graduate students have enrolled for the 2020 January Intersession than were enrolled in the 2019 January Intersession at this time last year. They are taking **4.6% more** credits than they were at this time last year. There are **3.7% more** graduate students enrolled for the 2020 January Intersession than the final enrollment count for the 2019 January Intersession, and this constitutes **same** credits.
