As of the most recent available data (January 01, 2020), 30.9% more undergraduates have enrolled for the 2020 January Intersession than were enrolled in the 2019 January Intersession at this time last year. They are taking 32.1% more credits than they were at this time last year. There are 29.7% more undergraduates enrolled for the 2020 January Intersession than the final enrollment count for the 2019 January Intersession, and this constitutes 34.4% more credits.

As of the most recent available data (January 01, 2020), 14.1% more graduate students have enrolled for the 2020 January Intersession than were enrolled in the 2019 January Intersession at this time last year. They are taking 10.1% more credits than they were at this time last year. There are 12.5% more graduate students enrolled for the 2020 January Intersession than the final enrollment count for the 2019 January Intersession, and this constitutes same credits.
