As of the most recent available data (January 02, 2020), 30.6% more undergraduates have enrolled for the 2020 January Intersession than were enrolled in the 2019 January Intersession at this time last year. They are taking 31.8% more credits than they were at this time last year. There are 28.8% more undergraduates enrolled for the 2020 January Intersession than the final enrollment count for the 2019 January Intersession, and this constitutes 33.6% more credits.

As of the most recent available data (January 02, 2020), 15.1% more graduate students have enrolled for the 2020 January Intersession than were enrolled in the 2019 January Intersession at this time last year. They are taking 11.1% more credits than they were at this time last year. There are 13.6% more graduate students enrolled for the 2020 January Intersession than the final enrollment count for the 2019 January Intersession, and this constitutes same credits.
