As of the most recent available data (January 07, 2020), 29.6% more undergraduates have enrolled for the 2020 January Intersession than were enrolled in the 2019 January Intersession at this time last year. They are taking 30.7% more credits than they were at this time last year. There are 27.2% more undergraduates enrolled for the 2020 January Intersession than the final enrollment count for the 2019 January Intersession, and this constitutes 31.4% more credits.

As of the most recent available data (January 07, 2020), 17.3% more graduate students have enrolled for the 2020 January Intersession than were enrolled in the 2019 January Intersession at this time last year. They are taking 13.5% more credits than they were at this time last year. There are 14.9% more graduate students enrolled for the 2020 January Intersession than the final enrollment count for the 2019 January Intersession, and this constitutes same credits.
