As of the most recent available data (January 15, 2020), 29.3% more undergraduates have enrolled for the 2020 January Intersession than were enrolled in the 2019 January Intersession at this time last year. They are taking 30.2% more credits than they were at this time last year. There are 26.9% more undergraduates enrolled for the 2020 January Intersession than the final enrollment count for the 2019 January Intersession, and this constitutes 30.9% more credits.

As of the most recent available data (January 15, 2020), 18.0% more graduate students have enrolled for the 2020 January Intersession than were enrolled in the 2019 January Intersession at this time last year. They are taking 14.2% more credits than they were at this time last year. There are 15.6% more graduate students enrolled for the 2020 January Intersession than the final enrollment count for the 2019 January Intersession, and this constitutes same credits.
