As of the most recent available data (**January 30, 2020**), **28.8% more** undergraduates have enrolled for the 2020 January Intersession than were enrolled in the 2019 January Intersession at this time last year. They are taking **29.7% more** credits than they were at this time last year. There are **26.4% more** undergraduates enrolled for the 2020 January Intersession than the final enrollment count for the 2019 January Intersession, and this constitutes **30.4% more** credits.

As of the most recent available data (**January 30, 2020**), **18.7% more** graduate students have enrolled for the 2020 January Intersession than were enrolled in the 2019 January Intersession at this time last year. They are taking **14.9% more** credits than they were at this time last year. There are **16.3% more** graduate students enrolled for the 2020 January Intersession than the final enrollment count for the 2019 January Intersession, and this constitutes **same** credits.
