As of the most recent available data (January 30, 2020), 28.8% more undergraduates have enrolled for the 2020 January Intersession than were enrolled in the 2019 January Intersession at this time last year. They are taking 29.7% more credits than they were at this time last year. There are 26.4% more undergraduates enrolled for the 2020 January Intersession than the final enrollment count for the 2019 January Intersession, and this constitutes 30.4% more credits.

As of the most recent available data (January 30, 2020), 18.7% more graduate students have enrolled for the 2020 January Intersession than were enrolled in the 2019 January Intersession at this time last year. They are taking 14.9% more credits than they were at this time last year. There are 16.3% more graduate students enrolled for the 2020 January Intersession than the final enrollment count for the 2019 January Intersession, and this constitutes same credits.
