As of the most recent available data (**November 05, 2020**), **15.7% more** undergraduates have enrolled for the 2021 January Intersession than were enrolled in the 2020 January Intersession at this time last year. They are taking **18.6% more** credits than they were at this time last year. There are **52.0% fewer** undergraduates enrolled for the 2021 January Intersession than the final enrollment count for the 2020 January Intersession, and this constitutes **47.7% fewer** credits.

As of the most recent available data (**November 05, 2020**), **25.3% more** graduate students have enrolled for the 2021 January Intersession than were enrolled in the 2021 January Intersession at this time last year. They are taking **58.0% more** credits than they were at this time last year. There are **72.6% fewer** graduate students enrolled for the 2020 January Intersession than the final enrollment count for the 2020 January Intersession, and this constitutes **67.4% fewer** credits.
