As of the most recent available data (**November 06, 2020**), **25.0% more** undergraduates have enrolled for the 2021 January Intersession at this time last year. They are taking **29.3% more** credits than they were at this time last year. There are **44.1% fewer** undergraduates enrolled for the 2021 January Intersession than the final enrollment count for the 2020 January Intersession, and this constitutes **39.0% fewer** credits.

As of the most recent available data (**November 06, 2020**), **29.1% more** graduate students have enrolled for the 2021 January Intersession than were enrolled in the 2021 January Intersession at this time last year. They are taking **59.9% more** credits than they were at this time last year. There are **67.6% fewer** graduate students enrolled for the 2020 January Intersession than the final enrollment count for the 2020 January Intersession, and this constitutes **61.5% fewer** credits.
