As of the most recent available data (November 11, 2020), 10.4% more undergraduates have enrolled for the 2021 January Intersession than were enrolled in the 2020 January Intersession at this time last year. They are taking 13.5% more credits than they were at this time last year. There are 35.9% fewer undergraduates enrolled for the 2021 January Intersession than the final enrollment count for the 2020 January Intersession, and this constitutes 30.7% fewer credits.

As of the most recent available data (November 11, 2020), 47.6% more graduate students have enrolled for the 2021 January Intersession than were enrolled in the 2021 January Intersession at this time last year. They are taking 63.6% more credits than they were at this time last year. There are 45.8% fewer graduate students enrolled for the 2020 January Intersession than the final enrollment count for the 2020 January Intersession, and this constitutes 39.6% fewer credits.
