As of the most recent available data (**November 13, 2020**), **1.6% more** undergraduates have enrolled for the 2021 January Intersession than were enrolled in the 2020 January Intersession at this time last year. They are taking **5.2% more** credits than they were at this time last year. There are **30.2% fewer** undergraduates enrolled for the 2021 January Intersession than the final enrollment count for the 2020 January Intersession, and this constitutes **24.9% fewer** credits.

As of the most recent available data (**November 13, 2020**), **53.4% more** graduate students have enrolled for the 2021 January Intersession at this time last year. They are taking **65.4% more** credits than they were at this time last year. There are **34.7% fewer** graduate students enrolled for the 2020 January Intersession than the final enrollment count for the 2020 January Intersession, and this constitutes **29.3% fewer** credits.
