As of the most recent available data (**November 18, 2020**), **16.9% more** undergraduates have enrolled for the 2021 January Intersession at this time last year. They are taking **18.1% more** credits than they were at this time last year. There are **11.2% fewer** undergraduates enrolled for the 2021 January Intersession than the final enrollment count for the 2020 January Intersession, and this constitutes **7.1% fewer** credits.

As of the most recent available data (**November 18, 2020**), 66.1% more graduate students have enrolled for the 2021 January Intersession than were enrolled in the 2021 January Intersession at this time last year. They are taking 76.0% more credits than they were at this time last year. There are 17.2% fewer graduate students enrolled for the 2020 January Intersession than the final enrollment count for the 2020 January Intersession, and this constitutes 11.6% fewer credits.
