As of the most recent available data (November 19, 2020), 19.5% more undergraduates have enrolled for the 2021 January Intersession than were enrolled in the 2020 January Intersession at this time last year. They are taking 20.2% more credits than they were at this time last year. There are 7.6% fewer undergraduates enrolled for the 2021 January Intersession than the final enrollment count for the 2020 January Intersession, and this constitutes 3.6% fewer credits.

As of the most recent available data (November 19, 2020), 67.6% more graduate students have enrolled for the 2021 January Intersession than were enrolled in the 2021 January Intersession at this time last year. They are taking 77.6% more credits than they were at this time last year. There are 14.0% fewer graduate students enrolled for the 2020 January Intersession than the final enrollment count for the 2020 January Intersession, and this constitutes 8.2% fewer credits.
