As of the most recent available data (**November 23, 2020**), **17.1% more** undergraduates have enrolled for the 2021 January Intersession than were enrolled in the 2020 January Intersession at this time last year. They are taking **18.6% more** credits than they were at this time last year. There are **4.0% fewer** undergraduates enrolled for the 2021 January Intersession than the final enrollment count for the 2020 January Intersession, and this constitutes **0.4% more** credits.

As of the most recent available data (**November 23, 2020**), **62.4% more** graduate students have enrolled for the 2021 January Intersession than were enrolled in the 2021 January Intersession at this time last year. They are taking **70.8% more** credits than they were at this time last year. There are **8.2% fewer** graduate students enrolled for the 2020 January Intersession than the final enrollment count for the 2020 January Intersession, and this constitutes **2.7% fewer** credits.
