As of the most recent available data (November 24, 2020), 17.8% more undergraduates have enrolled for the 2021 January Intersession than were enrolled in the 2020 January Intersession at this time last year. They are taking 18.8% more credits than they were at this time last year. There are 3.4% fewer undergraduates enrolled for the 2021 January Intersession than the final enrollment count for the 2020 January Intersession, and this constitutes 0.6% more credits.

As of the most recent available data (November 24, 2020), 70.1% more graduate students have enrolled for the 2021 January Intersession than were enrolled in the 2021 January Intersession at this time last year. They are taking 77.9% more credits than they were at this time last year. There are 3.8% fewer graduate students enrolled for the 2020 January Intersession than the final enrollment count for the 2020 January Intersession, and this constitutes same credits.
