As of the most recent available data (**December 01, 2020**), **18.6% more** undergraduates have enrolled for the 2021 January Intersession than were enrolled in the 2020 January Intersession at this time last year. They are taking **18.8% more** credits than they were at this time last year. There are **3.0% more** undergraduates enrolled for the 2021 January Intersession than the final enrollment count for the 2020 January Intersession, and this constitutes **6.7% more** credits.

As of the most recent available data (**December 01, 2020**), 64.7% more graduate students have enrolled for the 2021 January Intersession than were enrolled in the 2021 January Intersession at this time last year. They are taking 72.1% more credits than they were at this time last year. There are 0.6% fewer graduate students enrolled for the 2020 January Intersession than the final enrollment count for the 2020 January Intersession, and this constitutes same credits.
