As of the most recent available data (**December 11, 2020**), **16.8% more** undergraduates have enrolled for the 2021 January Intersession than were enrolled in the 2020 January Intersession at this time last year. They are taking **16.0% more** credits than they were at this time last year. There are **11.5% more** undergraduates enrolled for the 2021 January Intersession than the final enrollment count for the 2020 January Intersession, and this constitutes **15.1% more** credits.

As of the most recent available data (**December 11, 2020**), **29.8% more** graduate students have enrolled for the 2021 January Intersession than were enrolled in the 2021 January Intersession at this time last year. They are taking **35.7% more** credits than they were at this time last year. There are **11.7% more** graduate students enrolled for the 2020 January Intersession than the final enrollment count for the 2020 January Intersession, and this constitutes **same** credits.
