As of the most recent available data (**December 14, 2020**), **17.5% more** undergraduates have enrolled for the 2021 January Intersession than were enrolled in the 2020 January Intersession at this time last year. They are taking **16.0% more** credits than they were at this time last year. There are **12.7% more** undergraduates enrolled for the 2021 January Intersession than the final enrollment count for the 2020 January Intersession, and this constitutes **15.9% more** credits.

As of the most recent available data (**December 14, 2020**), **25.7% more** graduate students have enrolled for the 2021 January Intersession than were enrolled in the 2021 January Intersession at this time last year. They are taking **32.9% more** credits than they were at this time last year. There are **11.1% more** graduate students enrolled for the 2020 January Intersession than the final enrollment count for the 2020 January Intersession, and this constitutes **same** credits.
