As of the most recent available data (**December 15, 2020**), 23.4% more undergraduates have enrolled for the 2021 January Intersession than were enrolled in the 2020 January Intersession at this time last year. They are taking 21.9% more credits than they were at this time last year. There are 13.4% more undergraduates enrolled for the 2021 January Intersession than the final enrollment count for the 2020 January Intersession, and this constitutes 17.0% more credits.

As of the most recent available data (**December 15, 2020**), 25.7% more graduate students have enrolled for the 2021 January Intersession than were enrolled in the 2021 January Intersession at this time last year. They are taking 32.7% more credits than they were at this time last year. There are 11.4% more graduate students enrolled for the 2020 January Intersession than the final enrollment count for the 2020 January Intersession, and this constitutes same credits.
