As of the most recent available data (**December 16, 2020**), **18.4% more** undergraduates have enrolled for the 2021 January Intersession than were enrolled in the 2020 January Intersession at this time last year. They are taking **16.8% more** credits than they were at this time last year. There are **10.9% more** undergraduates enrolled for the 2021 January Intersession than the final enrollment count for the 2020 January Intersession, and this constitutes **14.4% more** credits.

As of the most recent available data (**December 16, 2020**), **21.9% more** graduate students have enrolled for the 2021 January Intersession than were enrolled in the 2021 January Intersession at this time last year. They are taking **29.4% more** credits than they were at this time last year. There are **8.7% more** graduate students enrolled for the 2020 January Intersession than the final enrollment count for the 2020 January Intersession, and this constitutes **same** credits.
