As of the most recent available data (**December 18, 2020**), **18.6% more** undergraduates have enrolled for the 2021 January Intersession than were enrolled in the 2020 January Intersession at this time last year. They are taking **19.0% more** credits than they were at this time last year. There are **14.6% more** undergraduates enrolled for the 2021 January Intersession than the final enrollment count for the 2020 January Intersession, and this constitutes **18.4% more** credits.

As of the most recent available data (**December 18, 2020**), **23.2% more** graduate students have enrolled for the 2021 January Intersession than were enrolled in the 2021 January Intersession at this time last year. They are taking **29.7% more** credits than they were at this time last year. There are **12.8% more** graduate students enrolled for the 2020 January Intersession than the final enrollment count for the 2020 January Intersession, and this constitutes **same** credits.
