As of the most recent available data (**December 23, 2020**), 20.3% more undergraduates have enrolled for the 2021 January Intersession than were enrolled in the 2020 January Intersession at this time last year. They are taking 21.0% more credits than they were at this time last year. There are 18.3% more undergraduates enrolled for the 2021 January Intersession than the final enrollment count for the 2020 January Intersession, and this constitutes 22.3% more credits.

As of the most recent available data (**December 23, 2020**), 22.5% more graduate students have enrolled for the 2021 January Intersession than were enrolled in the 2021 January Intersession at this time last year. They are taking 30.0% more credits than they were at this time last year. There are 15.7% more graduate students enrolled for the 2020 January Intersession than the final enrollment count for the 2020 January Intersession, and this constitutes same credits.
