As of the most recent available data (**January 01, 2021**), **22.5% more** undergraduates have enrolled for the 2021 January Intersession than were enrolled in the 2020 January Intersession at this time last year. They are taking **23.8% more** credits than they were at this time last year. There are **20.6% more** undergraduates enrolled for the 2021 January Intersession than the final enrollment count for the 2020 January Intersession, and this constitutes **24.9% more** credits.

As of the most recent available data (**January 01, 2021**), **28.9% more** graduate students have enrolled for the 2021 January Intersession than were enrolled in the 2021 January Intersession at this time last year. They are taking **37.4% more** credits than they were at this time last year. There are **27.4% more** graduate students enrolled for the 2020 January Intersession than the final enrollment count for the 2020 January Intersession, and this constitutes **same** credits.
