As of the most recent available data (January 01, 2021), 22.5% more undergraduates have enrolled for the 2021 January Intersession at this time last year. They are taking 23.8% more credits than they were at this time last year. There are 20.6% more undergraduates enrolled for the 2021 January Intersession than the final enrollment count for the 2020 January Intersession, and this constitutes 24.9% more credits.

As of the most recent available data (January 01, 2021), 28.9% more graduate students have enrolled for the 2021 January Intersession than were enrolled in the 2021 January Intersession at this time last year. They are taking 37.4% more credits than they were at this time last year. There are 27.4% more graduate students enrolled for the 2020 January Intersession than the final enrollment count for the 2020 January Intersession, and this constitutes same credits.
