As of the most recent available data (January 04, 2021), 22.0% more undergraduates have enrolled for the 2021 January Intersession than were enrolled in the 2020 January Intersession at this time last year. They are taking 23.2% more credits than they were at this time last year. There are 20.1% more undergraduates enrolled for the 2021 January Intersession than the final enrollment count for the 2020 January Intersession, and this constitutes 24.4% more credits.

As of the most recent available data (January 04, 2021), 30.1% more graduate students have enrolled for the 2021 January Intersession than were enrolled in the 2021 January Intersession at this time last year. They are taking 38.6% more credits than they were at this time last year. There are 28.6% more graduate students enrolled for the 2020 January Intersession than the final enrollment count for the 2020 January Intersession, and this constitutes same credits.
